Introduction

Welcome to Open Banking Exchange's cookie policy.

OBE S.A.S. (referred to in this document as “**Open Banking Exchange**”, “we”, “us” or “our”), is part of the Konsentus group and a wholly owned subsidiary of Konsentus Limited.

Open Banking Exchange respects your information and is committed to protecting it. This cookie policy will inform you as to how we utilize cookies on our website and what function those cookies perform.

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Cookies

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that store your authentication details as you move through restricted areas of the website.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, for example by remembering your admin area preferences on the admin preference page.
- **Targeting cookies.**

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie Title	Purpose	Retention Period
CookieConsent	Stores the user's cookie consent state for the current domain	1 year
pll_language	This cookie is used to determine the preferred language of the visitor and sets the language accordingly on the website, if possible.	1 year
vchideactivationmsg	Remembers whether the user has minimized or closed chat-box or pop-up messages on the website.	3 years
vchideactivationmsg_vc11	Collects data of the user's website navigation and activity, including name and contact details entered into forms.	3 years
lfuuid	Tracks the individual sessions on the website, allowing the website to compile statistical data from multiple visits. This data can also be used to create leads for marketing purposes.	3460 days

We do not share the information collected by the cookies with any third parties save where this is necessary for the technical operation of the cookie.

We require all third parties to respect the security of your personal data and to treat it in accordance with the law.

All cookies will expire at the end of the retention period set out in the table above.

You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.
